ECCL Safety Rules for Steel Target Range

- 1. Follow all **Firearm Safety Rules** when on shooting range.
- 2. Eye and Ear Protection is Required.
 - a. Suggested Certified Eye Protection with Side Shields (ANSI Z87.1)
- 3. Handgun and Pistol Caliber Cartridges Approved for Steel Targets
 - a. Maximum 1500fps Lead Ammo
 - b. Regular Jacketed Handgun Ammo is Allowed

4. AR-15 (or Similar) Rifles Allowed at any Target Set Up at 50yds

- a. Caliber Ammo Allowed; .223/5.56/300BLK
- 5. No High-Powered Rifles, 6mm or Higher, No shotguns on steel
- 6. Do Not Use the Following Ammunition (Use Magnet Provided to Check Ammo)
 - a. Armor Piercing
 - b. Steel Core or Steel Jacket
 - c. Solid Copper or Hardened Bullets
- 7. Firing Must Be Done within Designated Shooter Box at straight/forward position.
 - a. No Cross or Angle Shooting Allowed
- 8. Only Club Supplied Steel Targets are to be Used on this Range.
 - a. Do Not Move or Re-Position Steel Targets
- 9. Shoot Steel Targets at Own Risk.

10. No guests on the steel ranges

NOTE: All Damaged Steel Targets will be Removed from Range and Only Replaced when New Steel can be Acquired.
